

## **PCHS National Honor Society Chapter**

Beginning in the fall of 2009, the PCHS chapter of National Honor Society will invite eligible juniors and seniors to submit information packets for membership consideration. The selection process and induction ceremony will take place once each year, during the fall semester.

The criteria for selection are listed below:

- a. Candidates eligible for selection to this chapter must be members of the junior or senior class.
- b. To be eligible for selection to membership in this chapter, the candidate must have been in attendance for a period of one semester at Panther Creek High School.
- c. Candidates eligible for selection to the chapter shall have a minimum cumulative 3.6 weighted GPA. This scholastic level of achievement shall remain fixed and shall be the required minimum level of scholastic achievement for admission to candidacy. All students who can rise in scholarship to or above such standard may be admitted to candidacy for selection to membership.
- d. Candidates eligible for selection shall be enrolled in at least two honors classes during the academic year they are eligible.
- e. Candidates eligible for selection shall be subject to a discipline check with teachers and administrators.
- f. Upon meeting the grade level, attendance, GPA standard, course level, and discipline requirements, candidates shall then be considered based on their service, leadership, and character.
- g. Selection of members to this chapter shall be by a majority vote of the Faculty Council consisting of five faculty members appointed by the principal.
